TERMS OF USE

Welcome to our website. We are a non-profit organization registered in New York and with a registered office at 685 3rd Avenue, 12th Floor, New York, NY, 10017, United States of America.

The following terms of use ("Terms") govern your use of this site and the UN LGBTIQ+ Standards Tool ("the Tool") and serve as an agreement between you and us for your use of the site and the Tool.
